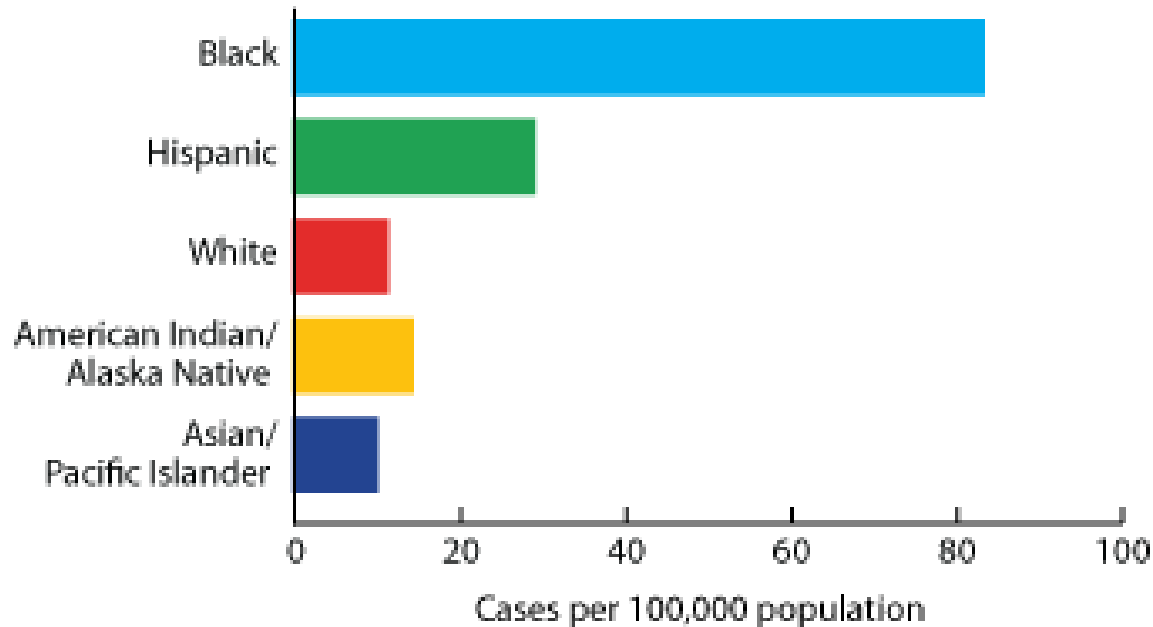

HIV Incidence Estimate

In 2008, CDC estimated that approximately 56,300 people were newly infected with HIV in 2006 (the most recent year that data was available).

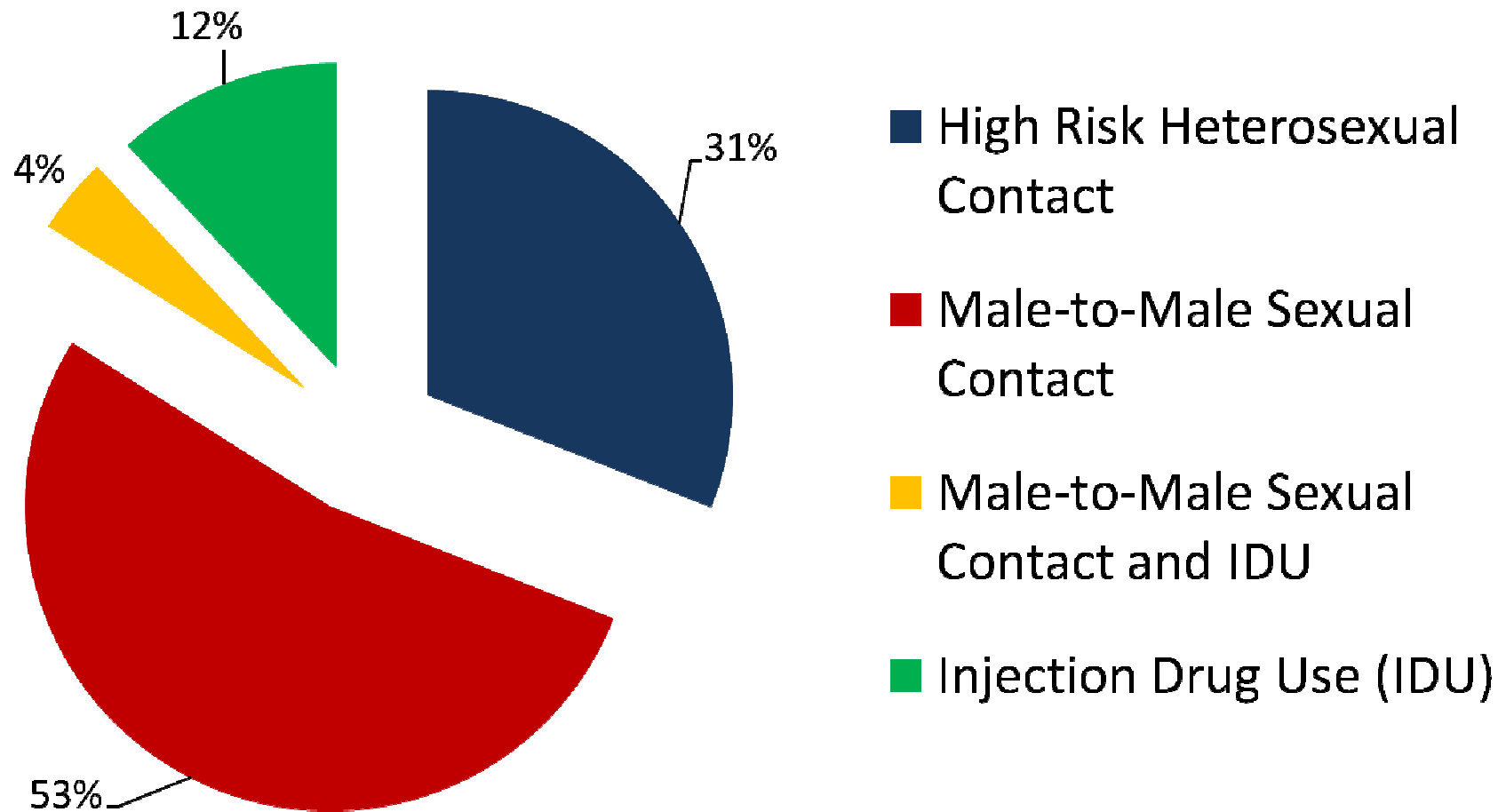
Over half (53%) of these new infections occurred in gay and bisexual men. African American men and women were also strongly affected and were estimated to have an incidence rate that was 7 times greater than the incidence rate among whites.



Blacks—In 2006, the rate of new infections among non-Hispanic blacks was 7 times the rate among whites (83.7 versus 11.5 new infections per 100,000 population). Blacks also accounted for the largest share of new infections (45%, or 24,900).

Hispanics—The rate of new HIV infections among Hispanics in 2006 was 3 times the rate among whites (29.3 versus 11.5 per 100,000), and Hispanics accounted for 17% of new infections (9,700).
